

## Terry McGuffin's THE QUICK & EASY BELL ©2013

Two shuttles  
Small dagger bead  
Size 12 pearl cotton in 2 shades  
Seed beads in size 11 or 8.  
Load 30 beads on shuttle 2.  
EASY! IF using direct method (no flip) chains so no RW  
is listed or used.  
All chains have either 3 picots or no picots.

Color: #1. R 2-2-2-2-2-2. (with white)  
Ch 4 - 4 - 3 - (slightly oversized p) 1  
Pull up loop in white thread, add seed bead, dagger  
bead, seed bead, paperclip.  
Snug up to work, ch 4  
Lift loaded picot up out of your way.

#2 R 2-2+ (to 4th p of PR) 2-2-2-2.  
Pull up bead onto white thread, Ch 2  
#3 R 2+ (LPPR) 2-2-2-2-2. P.U.bead, Ch 2  
#4 R 2+ (LPPR) 2-2-2-2-2. P.U. bead, Ch 2  
#5 R 2+ (LPPR) 2-2-2-2-2. P.U. bead, Ch 2  
#6 R 2+ (LPPR) 2-2-2-2-2. P.U. bead, Ch 3  
Slide sm. crochet hook in beaded loop, join, 1, add bead to next p, Ch 4 - 4 - 4  
#7 R 2-2+ (to 4th p of prev. ring) 2-2-2-2. Ch 4 - 4 - 3 add loop and p as in #2

Repeat #2-7 for pattern, 6 pattern repeats used in illustration.

Row 2 Join 2 colors to p before #1 ring, Ch 3, for large p, 1  
Join back into p with 3 beads on picot.  
Ch 3 + (to p on other side of R#1).  
Using direct (wrapping) method to set stitch of 4/4, 4/4, 4/4, 4/4, 4/4, 4/4, 4/4, 4/4 (for a total  
of (40 stitches) Note: Set stitch = 4 second half, 4 first half stitches for direct method.  
R 3-2-2-2-3 the 10 sets of 4/4.

Bottom: With 1 shuttle, ring of 1-10-10-10-10-10-9. Join into first p and lace into center  
of R#1 around.

Top R 3-2-2-3. \*Ch 4 - 4  
R 3+ (bead join to LPPR) 2-2-3. Ch 8  
R 3+ (bead join to LPPR) 2-2-3.

\* Work around repeating between \*s After I was done, I had to string a thread through  
center p of each ring. I removed the top, pulled the thread up tight, knotted it and glued  
it together. I then replaced the top and completed the lacing.
