

Angel with a Cluny Heart By Dagmar Pezzuto – Jan. 2018©

Abbreviations

DS = double stitch

DDS = double double stitch

R = ring

SR = split ring

CH = chain

CL = Cluny

+ = join

- = picot

clr = close ring

rw = reverse work

CTM = continuous thread method

2 shuttles or ball and tatting needle

Suggested thread = size 8

(Esterlina # 8 used in sample)



Begin Round one with shuttle wound in the continuous thread method.

R1 = 5DS – 5DS – 9DS. clr. rw

CL1 = 19 passes

CL2 = 19 passes + R1. rw

SR2 = 5DS – 5DS / 9DS. clr

CL3 = 19 passes

CL4 = 19 passes

R3 = 9 DS + (R2) 5DS – 5DS. clr.

SR4 = 5DS – 5DS / 9DS. clr. rw

CL5 = 19 passes

CL10 = 19 passes

R5 = 9DS +(R4) 5DS – 5DS. Clr

Repeat until completing 23 rings and 24 clunies.

$$SR24 = 10DS - 10DS + (R1) 10DS / 10DS. clr$$

$$CH1 = 18DS + (\mathbf{CL} 24, 23, 22, 21, 20, 19)$$

$$CH2 = 18DS + (\mathbf{CL} 18,17)$$

$$CH3 = 9DS - 9DS + (\mathbf{CL} 16,15)$$

$$CH4 = 9DS - 9DS + (\mathbf{CL} 14,13,12,11)$$

$$CH5 = 9DS + (CH4) 9DS + (\mathbf{CL} 10,9)$$

$$CH6 = 9DS - 9DS + (\mathbf{CL} 8,7)$$

$$CH7 = 18DS + (\mathbf{CL} 6,5,4,3,2,1)$$

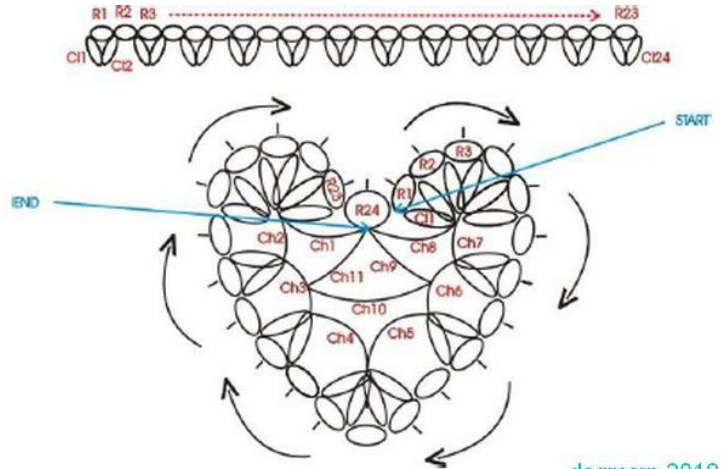
$$CH8 = 18DS + (R24)$$

$$CH9 = 16DDS + (CH3)$$

$$CH10 = 10DDS + (CH6)$$

$$CH11 = 16DDS + (CH24)$$

Finish off ends.



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
