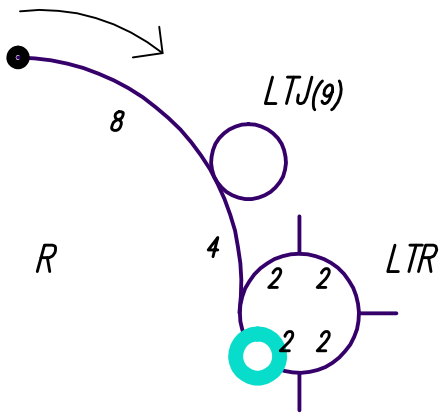
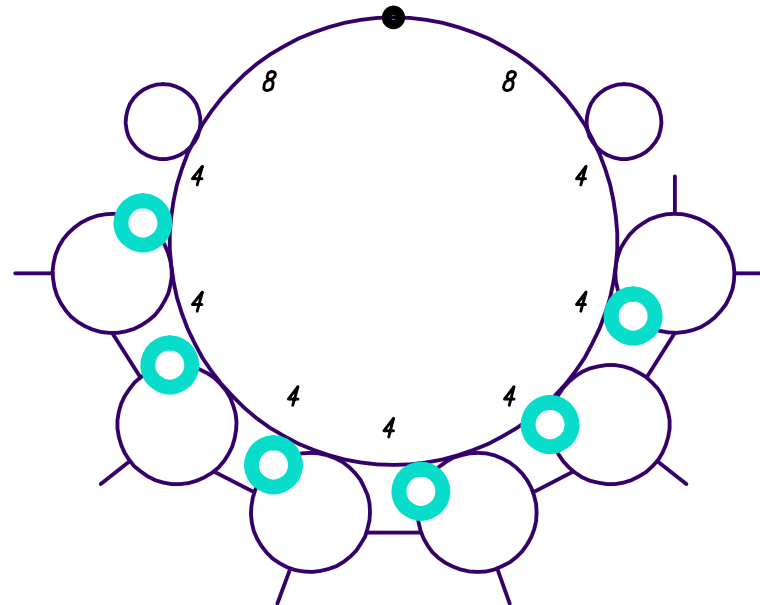


1-shuttle bookmark

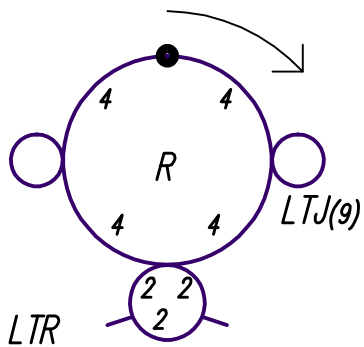

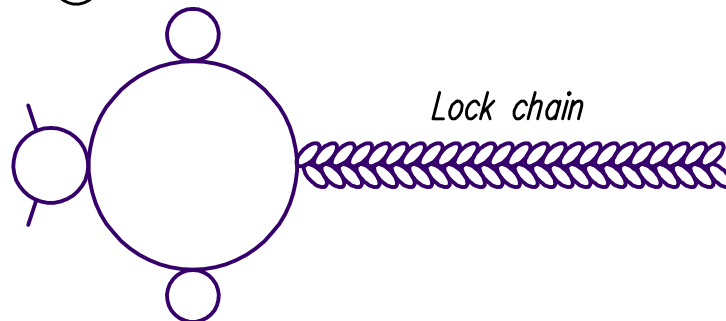

Abbreviations and colours:

SSSR – single shuttle split ring – pink lines

beads – blue circles

R – ring

LTJ (n) – loop tatted Josephine ring (number of half stitches)

LTR – loop tatted ring

A, B, C, D... – tating sequence

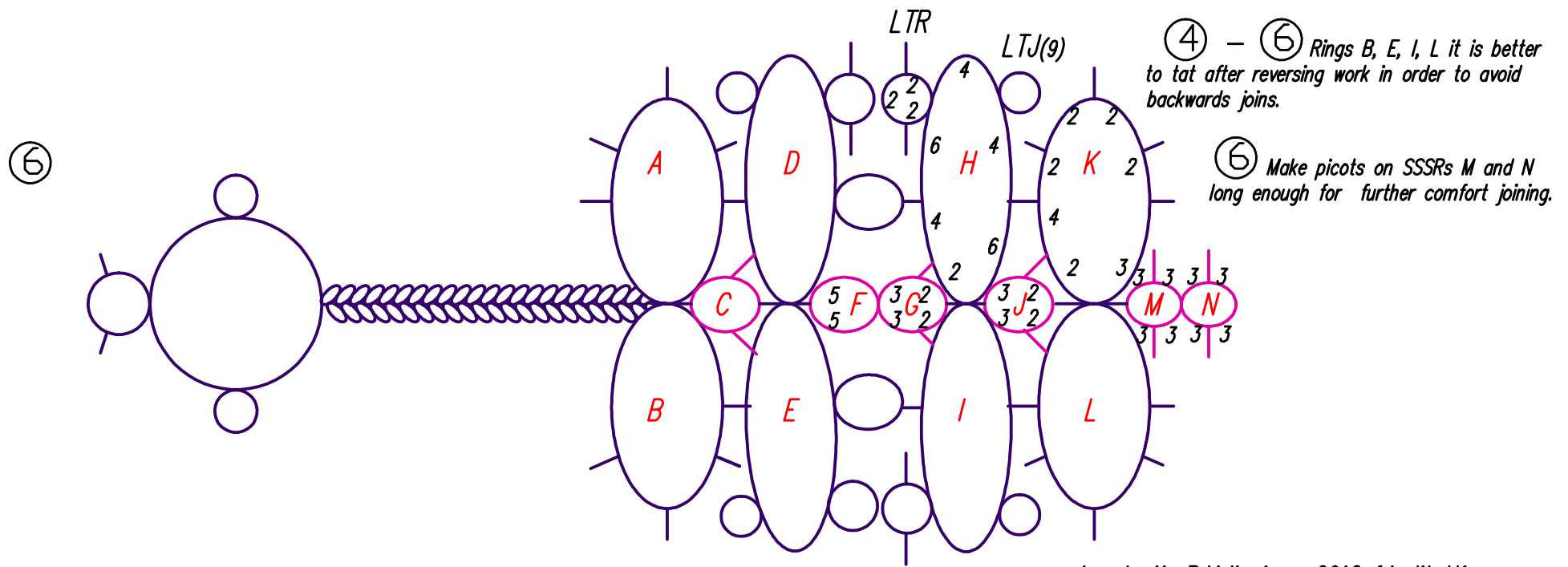
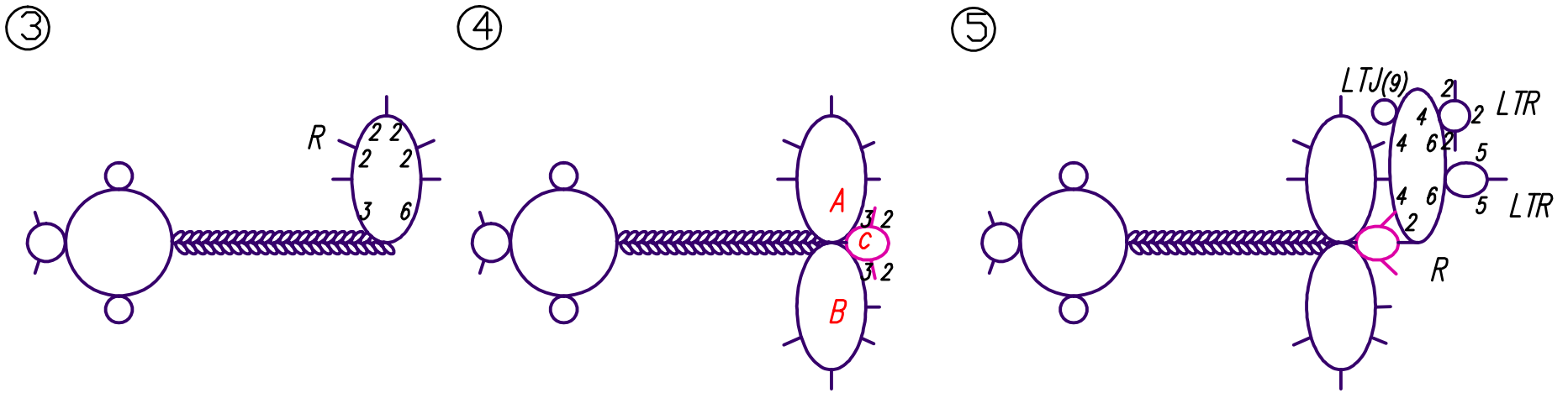
Leave 30 sm thread end before tating the 1st ring – it will be used in tating lock chain, which connects bookmark's tail and central part.

Bookmark's tail Variant A:

① A Before tating add 6 beads to the shuttle thread. All these beads should be on the thread slipped round the left hand. Begin to tat ring. Before tating LTR add 1 bead to the loop. Tighten LTR without slipping the loop round LTR and without passing sh through the loop.

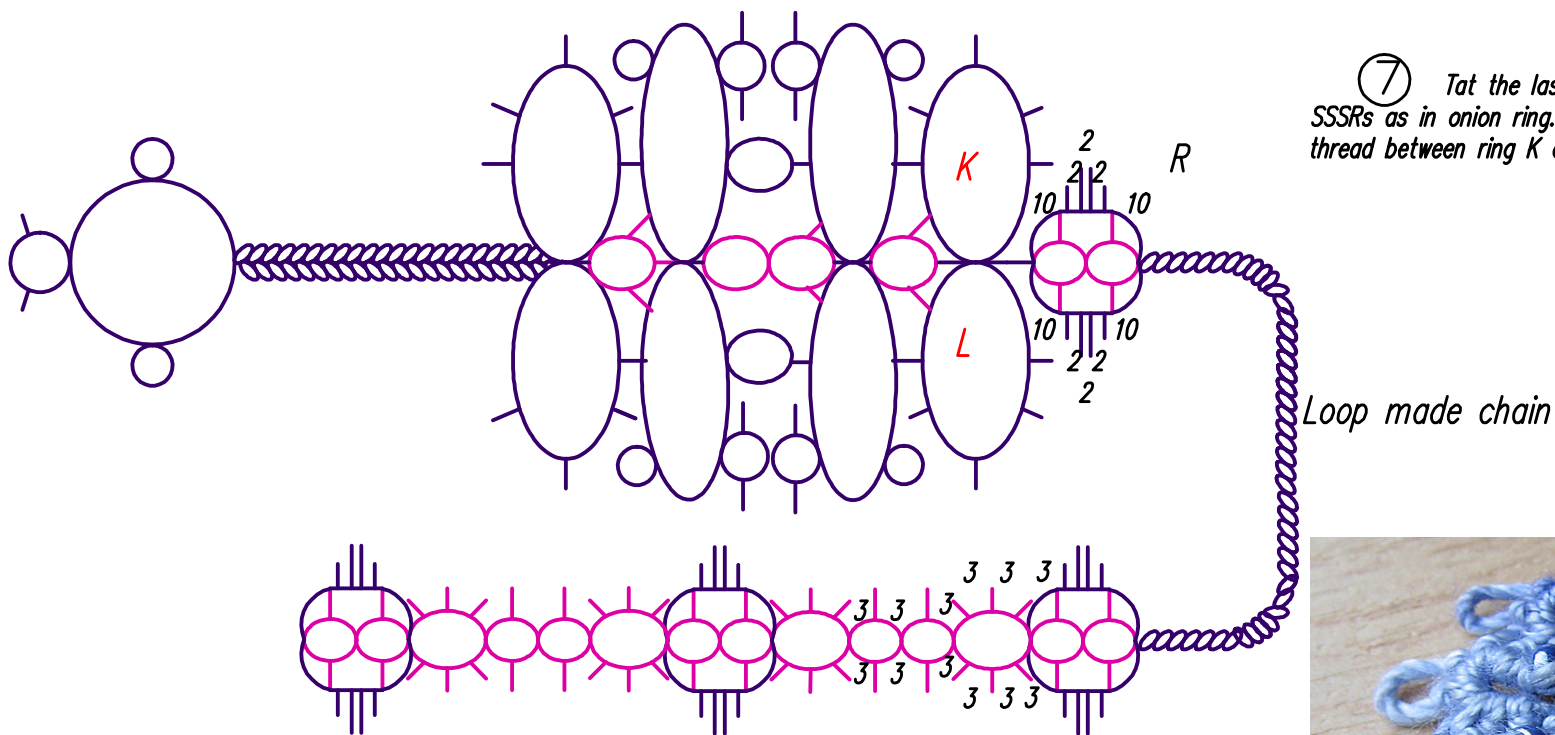
② B Lock chain – tat 1st half stitch as usual, tat 2nd half stitch without flipping the loop. Repeat as many times as needed.

⑦ Tat the last ring, joining to the picots of SSSRs as in onion ring. The middle join is with the thread between ring K and ring L.
