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R 4+4-4-4. Clr. Rw
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Repeat from * 5 times more, joining the last ring to the first ring.

Ch 2 ---- jlp,jlp, r [4-4. cr], jlp, jlp,jlp, 1. Join to the base of the first ring.

I finished the motif with a zigzag chain


<u>Chain detail</u>


Begin the chain, with 2 double stitches, then a long picot, aprox 2 inches horizontal. Then you have to make the dan rusch wide picot as follows..

Join long picot (jlp)

With the crochet hook, from back to front, pull the working thread through the long picot, forming a loop. Now you have to tat the 1st half stitch over this loop (replace the working thread with this new loop in your hand). Then put the working thread in your hand again and tat the 2nd half stich. Repeat this sequence for the desired picot width.
