ABBREVIATIONS

ds = double stitch

R = ring

Ch = chain

+ = join

- = picot

-- = long picot

Clr = close ring

CTM = continuous thread method

vsp = very small picot

JR = Josephine ring

OR = Onion ring

S = Shuttle (4)

Needle tatting = 1

Threads Mercer 20 = red – green – yellow

S1 = RED

S2 = RED

S3 = GREEN

S4 = GREEN

Needle Tatting = YELLOW

swirl join = redemoinho



1º ROUND *

Start whit CTM – Thread red

OR1 = 7ds –(vsp) 7ds. Clr. 12ds + (vsp) 12ds Clr.

Ch1 = 5ds JR (10 ds) 5ds JR (10ds) 5ds JR(10ds) 5ds

Repeat 5x. Join all the petals using the swirl technique.

Join the green wire at the base of the 1st petal to the stem and leaves.

STEM

Ch1 = 12ds

RS3 = 6ds – 6ds Clr.

Ch2 = 2ds

RS4 = 6ds – 6ds Clr.

Ch3 = 12ds
 RS4 = 5ds – 5ds Clr.
 Ch4 = 7ds
 RS3 = 5ds – 5ds Clr.
 Ch5 = 10ds
 Leave long wires.

FLOWER BUD

R1 = 7ds - (vsp) 7ds Clr.
 OR = 12ds +(vsp R1) 12ds Clr.

Join the green wire at the base of the 1st petal to the stem and leaves.

Ch1 = 15ds
 RS3 = 6ds – 6ds Clr.
 Ch2 = 10ds

The amount of leaves and stem length is optional.

YELLOW SMALL BOW

Use needle tatting

Ch1 = 20ds. Clr
 Ch2 = 20ds. Clr

Use the rococo technique in tatting.
