ABBREVIATIONS
R: ring
Ch: chain
SP : Split ring picot

## VASE

R1 = 4DS - 4DS. Cl.
Ch = 8DS( +) - 8DS. Cl.
Ch = 14DS( +) - 14DS. Cl.
$\mathrm{Ch}=10 \mathrm{DS}$

R3 $=4 \mathrm{DS}-4 \mathrm{DS} . \mathrm{Cl}$.
Ch = 8DS $(+)-8 D S . C l$.
SR 3 = 18DS/18DS. CL
$R 2, R 4, R 5, R 7 R 8$ are equal to $R 1$.
$R 6$ and $R 9$ are equal to $R 3$.

## MOUTH VASE

Ch = Make as many points as necessary to surround the mouth of the vase. Make the picot as needed. Cut and tie.

BRACE YELLOW
R = 3DS- 3DS. Cl.
$\mathrm{Ch}=30 \mathrm{DS}$
SR = 3DS/3DS. Cl.
Ch = 15DS + R. Cut and tie.

## FLOWERS

10 flower
Ch = 15 DS (double) vsp 5 DS vsp 15 DS - (picot inverted) 6 DS.
R1 = 3DS - 3DS. CI.
Ch = 6DS + ( - R1) 6DS. Cl.
R2 $=3 D S-3 D S$. Cl .
Ch = 6DS + (-R2) 6DS. Cl.
Ch $=6 \mathrm{DS}+$ down picot.
Repeated twice to form a flower. Cut and tie.

## 20 and 30 flower

Ch = CTM in 10 picot 15 DS - (down picot). Make the flower.
Ch $=$ CTM in 20 picot 18 DS - (down picot). Make the flower.
