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ABBREVIATIONS

CH = chain

HCL = hanging cluny

Clr = close ring

CTM = continuous thread method

ds = double stitch

rw = reverse work

- = picot

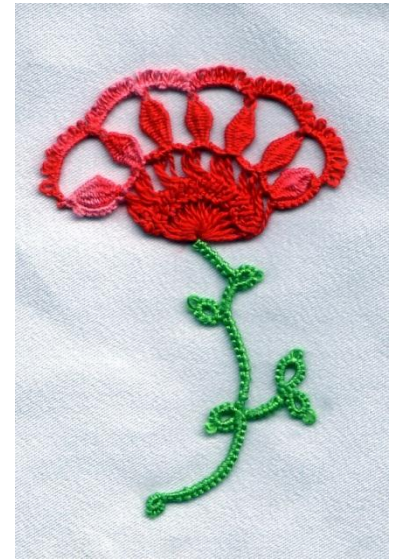
JR = Josephine ring

hp = hairpin

1 shuttle

1 needle

1 floss threader loop



HAIRPIN: make lace with 28 loops. Join the one side making the half circle.

TATTING

FLOWER

1^o ROUND

HCL1 = 15 passes (leave a picot in the cluny) + 1* handle = + to first gathered group of 4 hp loops, CH 2 and + to next gathered group of 4 hp loops

HCL2 = 15 passes (leave a picot in the cluny) + 2* handle = + to next gathered group of 4 hp loops, CH 2 and + to next gathered group of 4 hp loops.

Make a total of 7 cluny petals

2^o ROUND

8 ds + HCL 7

Ch 1 = 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds + HCL 6

Ch2 = 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds – 1ds + HCL 5

Repeat for all petals.

8 ds + 1^a HCL.

STEM

Ch1 = 7 ds

R1 = 4ds – 4ds Clr. RW

Ch2 = 4ds

R2 = 4ds – 4ds Clr.

Ch3 = 12ds – 6ds

R3 = 6ds – 6ds Clr.

R4 = 4ds – 4ds Clr. Cut and Tie

JR = 10ds Clr.

Ch4 = 18ds + (- Ch3)

R6 = 6ds – 6ds Clr. Cut and Tie.
