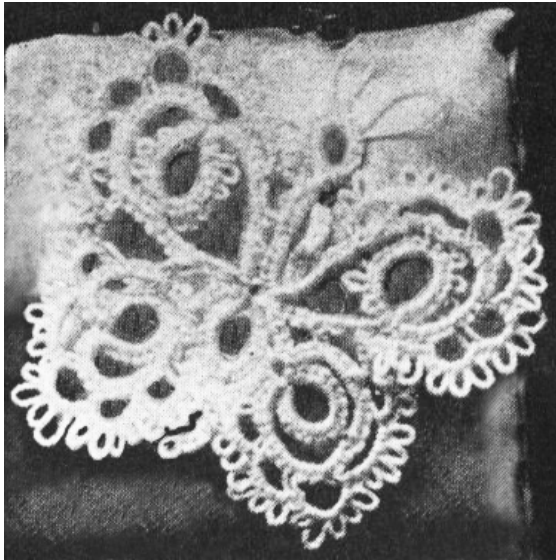

Anna Wuerful Brown's Butterfly #605



Eight pages of Anna Wuerful Brown's Book #6 "Gift Novelties in Tatting" were reprinted in Handy Hands Tatting's "Helping Hands Newsletter", vol.10 Issue 2 Spring/Summer 2002. On page 16 (of the original booklet) there is shown a butterfly decorating a ribbon sachet. It is item #655 with Butterfly #605. However, the instructions for the butterfly were on page 2 which was not reprinted.

Here are the original directions as written. If anyone would like to rewrite the pattern in modern notation, please send to me and I will add it to this page. A sample in colored thread would also be nice to add.

No. 605. Small Butterfly CORDONNET No. 30

Small butterfly (see outside front cover [of Anna Wuerfel Brown's Book #6 "Gift Novelties in Tatting", 1916]) for handle of basket, or anywhere it can be used to advantage.

UW means upper wing; LW lower wing.

Begin at head.

R 7 d, 1 p 3 d, 1 p 7 d, right side upper body (UB) ch, 6 d, p, 6 d; lower body (LB), r, 5 d (p 5 d) 3 times, turn.

Right upper wing.

6 d join to p in UB, 3 d (p 3 d) twice, l-r [large ring??], 2 d, (p 2 d) 11 times, turn, ch 3 d (p 3 d) 5 times, join 6th p of l-r, ch 3 d (p 3 d) twice, join between upper and lower bodies.

LW,

ch, 4 d join 1st p of lower body, ch 3 d join last p of UW (3 d p) twice, 3 d, turn, r, 8 d, join 1st p of LB. 8 d, turn, ch 3 d (p 3 d) 4 times, join same 1st p of LB, ch, 5 d, join 2nd p of LB, r, 4 d, p, 4 d, turn, cl 1 d, p. 1 d, p, 1 d, join last p of LW * ch (1 d p) 3 times, 1 d, join next p *, repeat from * to * 3 times,

ch, 2 d, join next p of UW* ch (1 d, p) 3 times, 1 d, join next p * repeat from * to * twice, ch, 1 d (p 1 d) 5 times, join next p of UW, ch (1 d, p) 3 times, join next p. ch, 1d (p 1 d) 3 times, join next p, ch, 2 d. cross threads around neck and repeat from beginning of UB for left side, omitting the small r at lower end of body.
