

EARRING WITH MALTESE CHAIN

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Abbreviations

CTM = Continuous thread method

CH = Chain

FR = Floating ring

+ = Join

- = Picot

3 threads = 2 with (1 Shuttle 1 and 1 ball) and 1 rose (shuttle 2).e

ds = double stitch

 = seed bead

 = large seed bead

 = large bead.

Round 1 = 2 shuttle (thread with and rose) 1 ball (thread with).

Round 2 = 1 shuttle and 1 fabric needle (threads with).



ROUND 1

11 large seed bead in shuttle 1

Maltese chain = 3ds (shuttle 2), slide 1 large seed bead , 3ds (shuttle 2).

Complete around.

Joining the maltese chain, leaving two long threads. Use fabric glue to the knot does not undo.

ROUND 2

Put 160 seed beads in one shuttle.

CTM

Start on the 1ds maltese chain.

Pass the needle through 1st large seed bead.

CH 1 = 1ds  1ds - 1ds  1eadd.

Pass the needle through 2^a large seed bead.

Make all around.

CH11 = 1ds  1ds     1ds  1ds.

Pass the needle through 1^a large seed bead.

CH 12 = 1ds     1ds FR     1ds Clr + (- CH1).

Make all around

Cut & Tie.

Pass the threads of maltese chain inside the big account and put 14 large seed beads

Put the thread into the large bead. Give a small knot at the junction of the maltese chain and put a drop of glue fabric to not undo the knot.

Hide the ends inside the big bead.

This large bead

OBS: This large bead must have a big hole to fit all the wires.
